Life at Cooper

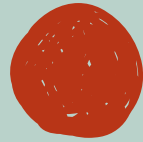
- **Masks**

- Doesn't affect our safe learning environment

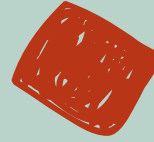
- **Renovations**

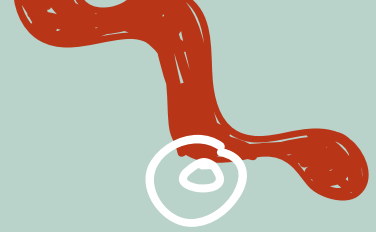
Cooper vs. Longfellow Basketball Game

- Variety of fun prizes





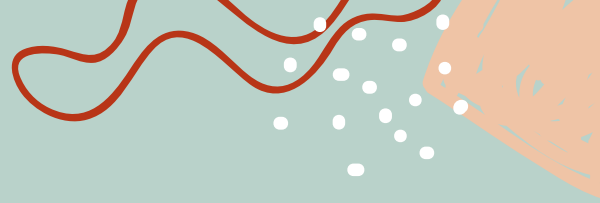

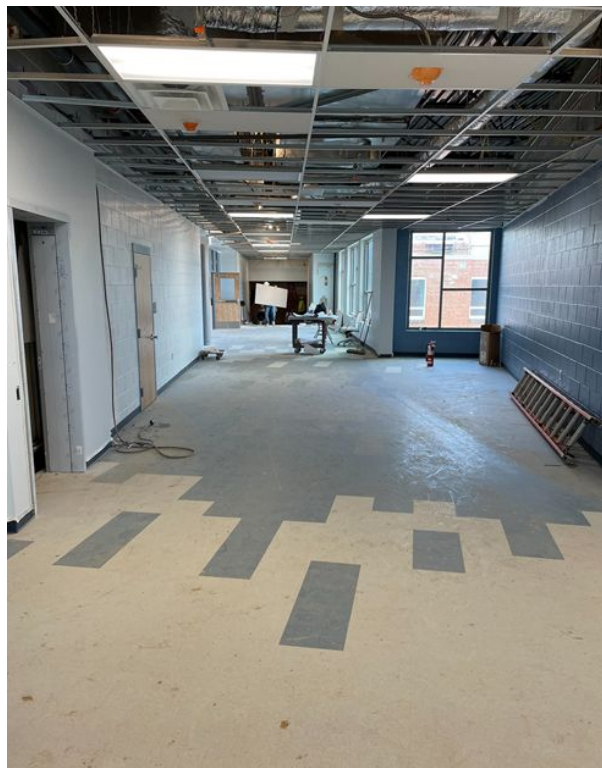

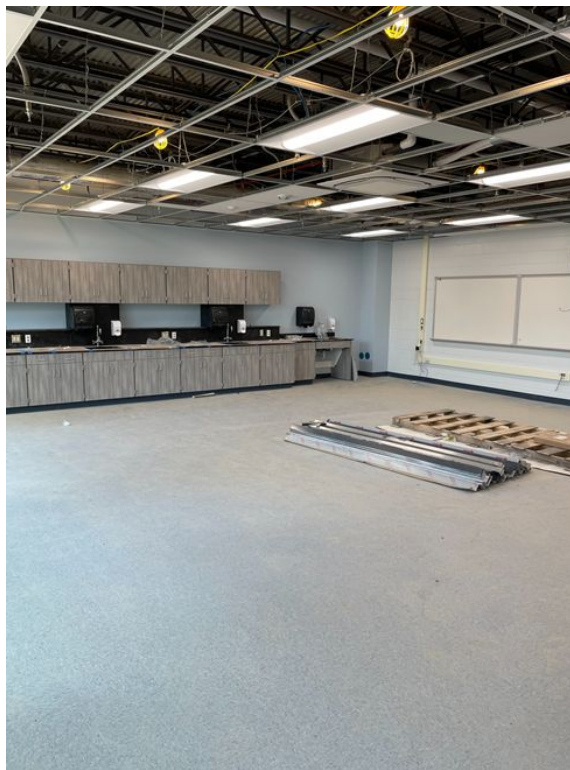
